


Many surgery patients say they are worried about pain control after surgery, especially after they leave the hospital. We want to make sure you feel educated about your pain medicines and the best way to take them to help decrease these worries and improve your healing.

Pain is a normal and expected part of the healing process after surgery. Just like any injury (i.e. sunburn, finger cut), your pain will get better over time as your body heals itself. To best control your pain and avoid medications with poor side effects and addictive properties, we recommend "multimodal analgesia" or "MMA". MMA works by using different pain medications that each works on different targets to control your pain. When these medications are taken together, they decrease multiple pain sources at once, giving you better pain relief. Although MMA is expected to reduce your pain and help you get back to some normal activities, MMA will not completely eliminate all of your pain.




